Recipes

White Christmas Crunch Squares

(taken from [www.kraftfoods.com](http://www.kraftfoods.com))



What You Need

32 PREMIUM Hint of Salt Saltine Crackers

1/2 cup butter

3/4 cup packed brown sugar

1 pkg. (6 squares) BAKER'S White Chocolate, coarsely chopped

1/4 cup crushed candy canes

Make It

HEAT oven to 350°F.

ARRANGE crackers in single layer in foil-lined 15x10x1-inch pan.

COOK butter and sugar in saucepan on medium-high heat 3 to 4 min. or until butter is melted and mixture is well blended, stirring occasionally. Bring to boil; cook 3 min. (Do not stir.) Spread onto crackers.

BAKE 4 to 6 min. or until golden brown. Immediately top with chocolate; bake 1 to 2 min. or until melted. Spread chocolate to completely cover crackers; top with crushed candy. Cool completely. Break into squares.

## Cheesy Christmas Tree



### What You Need

- 1 pkg. (8 oz.) PHILADELPHIA Cream Cheese
- 1/2 cup pesto
- 1/4 cup chopped red peppers
- 1 stick KRAFT POLLY-O TWIST-UMS String Cheese
- RITZ Crackers

### Make It

CUT block of cream cheese diagonally in half. Arrange both halves, with points together, on serving plate to resemble Christmas-tree shape.

CUT a 2-inch piece from the string cheese. Place at bottom of tree for the trunk. Wrap up remaining cheese; refrigerate until ready to use for snacking or other use.

SPOON pesto over cream cheese; sprinkle with peppers. Serve as a spread with the crackers

## Crispy Chocolate Clusters



### What You Need

- 1/2 cup PLANTERS Dry Roasted Peanuts
- 1 pkg. (8 squares) BAKER'S Semi-Sweet Chocolate
- 2-1/2 cups corn flakes
- 1/2 cup dried cranberries
- 24 JET-PUFFED HOLIDAY MALLOWES Marshmallows

### Make It

CRUSH peanuts into small pieces; set aside.

COVER baking sheet with waxed paper. Melt chocolate in large microwaveable bowl as directed on package, following microwave directions. Add corn flakes, cranberries and peanuts; stir gently until evenly coated with chocolate.

USE large spoon to drop cereal mixture into 24 clusters on prepared baking sheet.

TOP each with marshmallow. Refrigerate 1 hour or until firm.
