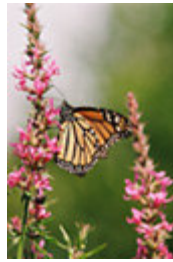

Recipes

Kickin' Buffalo Cheese Bites



What You Need

3 oz. KRAFT Colby & Monterey Jack Cheese, cut into 12 slices

½ cup finely chopped cooked chicken breast

2 Tbsp. hot pepper sauce for Buffalo wings

24 RITZ Crackers

2 Tbsp. KRAFT ROKA Blue Cheese Dressing

Make It

CUT cheese slices diagonally in half. Toss chicken with sauce. Top crackers with cheese and chicken mixture; place 6 on microwaveable plate.

MICROWAVE on HIGH 10 to 15 sec. or until cheese begins to melt. Repeat with remaining topped crackers.

DRIZZLE with dressing. Serve warm

Cheesy Corn Dog Bake



What You Need

- 1 pkg. (8-1/2 oz.) corn muffin mix
- 1 cup frozen corn, thawed
- 4 OSCAR MAYER Bun-Length Wieners, cut lengthwise in half
- 4 KRAFT DELI DELUXE Process American Cheese Slices, cut diagonally in half

Make It

HEAT oven to 400°F.
PREPARE muffin batter as directed on package. Stir in corn.
POUR into 8-inch square pan sprayed with cooking spray; top with wieners.
BAKE 20 to 25 min. or until cornbread is golden brown. Top with cheese; cover. Let stand 5 min. or until melted.

OREO Football Cookie Balls



What You Need

- 6 oz. (3/4 of 8-oz. pkg.) PHILADELPHIA Cream Cheese, softened
- 1 pkg. (15.25 oz.) OREO Chocolate Creme Cookies, finely crushed
- 2 pkg. (8 squares each) BAKER'S Semi-Sweet Chocolate, melted
- 1 Tbsp. white decorating icing

Make It

MIX cream cheese and cookie crumbs until well blended.
SHAPE into 40 (1-inch) football shapes. Freeze 10 min. Dip in melted chocolate; place in single layer in shallow waxed paper-lined pan. Use icing to draw laces on footballs.
REFRIGERATE 1 hour or until firm.
